 - o WEDC provides funding to the Small Business Development Centers, UW-Superior and UW-Eau Claire. Starting new this year, small businesses with 20 employees or less are eligible to get free consulting if they need help with a business plan, financial statements, etc.
 - o Small Business Development Grants will be announced in the next month.
 - Vibrant Spaces Grant will be announced in February.
 - o WEDC is about halfway through the fiscal year, so projects should be brought forward soon (by mid-April) to be included in FY25 consideration.

- Dale H. Park Falls has two major projects that they are in the final stages of completion YMCA and the hospital – new bank – Prentice wastewater treatment plant is finalized – manufacturers are expanding in Prentice

 with Washburn County to fund the EDC partnering with CEDA to provide consulting services two
